Dear Workshop Participant,

We look forward to welcoming you to Anderson Ranch Arts Center. This letter includes the list of supplies for your workshop and a general schedule of events that commonly occur during a typical workshop. We encourage students to join their faculty and class for the Sunday welcome dinner starting at 6 pm as well as faculty presentations at 7 pm on Sunday and Tuesday evenings. Students should plan to attend our Monday morning orientation at 8:45 am in Schermer Meeting Hall. Other events may include the Featured Artists Lecture Series and Friday auctionettes.

The health and safety of Ranch visitors and staff are our top priority. During the global COVID-19 pandemic we have adjusted our operations in accordance with local public health orders. Thank you for helping to keep our community safe by following the Five Commitments of Containment listed below and adhering to our Business Safety Plan available for your review on our website. As guidelines change, we will revise this plan and notify you of changes to our operations.

5 Commitments of Containment:

1. I will maintain six feet of distance from anyone not in my household.
2. I will wash my hands often.
3. I will cover my face in public.
4. I will stay home when I am sick.
5. I will seek testing immediately and self-report if I experience symptoms.

Your studio fee will provide the following: various paper, cotton rags, solvents, easels, scissors, pushpins, masking tapes, hand tools, rulers, clamps, staple guns, projector, computer use, and studio maintenance & cleaning. Gamsol is the only solvent allowed in the painting studio. Please do not bring encaustic materials unless the workshop is encaustic. Please do not bring cobalt driers, spray paints, or alcohol-based products. The store at Anderson Ranch has a great selection of art supplies. We may not carry all supplies on your list. **If you purchase your class supplies ahead of time through The ArtWorks Store, we offer a 10% discount.** For questions or to place an order, please contact info@andersonranch.org or 970-923-3181.

*Keep in mind that Anderson Ranch is located in a remote mountain town. Some equipment and materials will be difficult to find locally. Please plan accordingly and **order your supplies before the workshop start date.** Each workshop has its own requirements and dynamics that may necessitate changes in this overview. Please bring the following tools and supplies to your workshop available in The ArtWorks Store:

- Ex-Acto knife and blades
- 1" blue painters tape or artist tape
- Compressed charcoal, vine charcoal, and erasers (enough for two medium drawings)
- Drawing pencil and eraser (your choice)
- Gloss gel medium (8oz)
- Metal ruler

- Medium size watercolor sketchbook (at least 8.5" x 11"- NOT a watercolor block)
- Black drawing ink (Sumi, India, Higgins, etc.)
- Basic set of watercolor brushes
- Acrylic brushes (one small, medium, and large)
- 3" cheap house painting brush
- Your choice of basic watercolor or acrylic set of paints for color exercises
- Set of Sakura Pigma Micron Pens black (Sizes 005, 01, 02, 03, 05, 08)

Please bring the following tools and supplies to your workshop not available in The ArtWorks Store:

- 1 Pentel pocket brush pen (black)
- 2 Niji waterbrush (one small and one large)
- 4-6 water color pencils (complementary colors)
- 1 chartpak blender marker
- 1 container for water to clean brushes
- Collage materials (magazines, newspapers, photographs, etc.)
- 2 or more images of your choice, printed to full 8.5" x 11" paper size to be used as a reference image for drawing exercise (brighter and/or high contrast images work best)
- 1 small water spray bottle
- 1 small gesso panel 8" x 10"
- 1 clayboard panel 8"x10"

In preparation for your workshop, please plan for packing materials that you want to use to ship your project home, like moving blankets, packing tape, bubble wrap or cardboard boxes.

Getting your supplies to the Ranch: You are welcome to ship your supplies to the Ranch via UPS or FedEx to arrive at the Ranch the week before your workshop clearly labeled as shown below. Unidentified packages may be returned. Please label your packages as follows:
