# 5th Grade School Field Trips at Anderson Ranch Arts Center

### **The Ranch:**

At Anderson Ranch, we recognize human beings' lifelong need to develop personal creativity and to discover, learn and grow. Artists of all levels come from across the country and around the world to explore new ideas, hone their art-making skills and engage in meaningful dialog at the Ranch. Both an international center and a close community, Anderson Ranch welcomes children, teens, and adults—from beginners to the leading artists of our time.

### **The Trip:**

We offer field trips to 5th-grade students in the Roaring Fork Valley. While at Anderson Ranch Arts Center, local Roaring Fork Valley students can explore, create and interact with art. A field trip to Anderson Ranch will include a visit to our campus and art-making in our studios. Students should bring lunch to eat together in our Ranch Cafe. Students will spend two and a half hours on our campus from **9:30 AM-12 PM**. Our field trips are also guided by 5th Grade Colorado State Standards in the Visual Arts.

### **Field Trip Expectations:**

- The school will provide transportation to and from Anderson Ranch.
- Classes are expected to complete the school-provided field trip form along with our Ranch waiver. Copies of our waiver are attached in both English and Spanish.
- We request that there is one adult present for every 10 students.
- We ask that all students and adults stay together and work together as we tour studios and engage in art-making.
- Anderson Ranch follows Pitkin Country COVID-19 guidelines and will follow current guidelines at the time of the field trip.
