Welcome to Anderson Ranch's Virtual Ceramics Workshops! We're thrilled to have you join us and connect with artists from around the world. At Anderson Ranch, our goal is to nurture creativity and foster artistic growth through community, exploration, and hands-on learning.

Workshop Details & Recording Access

All Virtual Ceramics Workshops are 2-2.5 hours long and are scheduled in Mountain Standard Time (MST).

After the session, the Zoom recording will be uploaded to a shared folder. Access to the recording will be available for 60 days, allowing you to revisit the lesson at your convenience.

What to Expect

- Learn from expert faculty about their creative process.
- Ask questions and engage with the instructor.
- Discover useful techniques, tips, and inspiration for your practice.
- Join a supportive community of artists eager to learn, share, and grow.

How to Use This Course

Navigating the Content: All essential materials—Zoom links, supply lists (if applicable), and resources—will be emailed to you before the workshop. Follow along with your session and reference these materials as needed.

Engagement: During the live workshop, you can choose to have your camera on or off and ask questions through the chat function. The final 10 minutes of the workshop are reserved for live questions with audio. While you're welcome to create during the demonstration, we recommend focusing on taking notes, asking questions, and rewatching the recordings as you practice later.

Access to the Recording: Missed something? The Zoom recording will be available within 24 hours and will be accessible for 60 days. Feel free to pause, rewind, and revisit any part as you work at your own pace.

Take Notes & Practice: Keep a sketchbook or notebook handy to jot down ideas, questions, and reflections. Practice the techniques in your own studio while reviewing the recording.

Preparation: Test your Zoom account access and ensure you're ready to log in before the live session begins.

How long do I have access to the workshop?

You'll have live access on the day of the workshop and access to the recording for 60 days.

Can I create alongside the instructor?

Yes, you're welcome to work alongside the instructor during the live session. However, many students prefer to take notes and practice later using the recording.

Can I cancel my registration?

Workshop tuition is charged in full at the time of registration. Tuition for Virtual Workshops is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Can I record the live session?

No, recording the live session is not permitted. However, you'll have access to the official workshop recording for 60 days.
